Nursery received the tee pees and are enjoying them in each room. Tea & Coffee well appreciated by staff at Parent Contact and Jingle Jog.	
Jingle Jog raised over £400 and looking to be an annual event.	
Head Teacher Update/Report (see attached document) Lovely if the local councillor could come and thank Louise Mitchell for her service as she has been with us for so long – open invitation to Morven and Trish.	
Supply List - some names on the supply list are Teachers who have secured full-time work and do not come off the list as it may take 3/6 months to get back on it if needed. Still an issue with the PSA list and getting supply for reduced hours across the school. Aileen has looked herself at other systems (NHS and CALA) and sent her investigation to Highland Council to help with this ongoing issue.	
CG - (in reference to school being closed on Wednesday due to staff absences rather than snow) Even if we could have got 16 members of	

staff for the days closed, they do not know the children or their needs and leaves them vulnerable. It is safer for everyone to close the school.

KB - is there anyway to block certain comments on the Facebook page because some were unacceptable.

CH - we have tried but unfortunately haven't been able to AM - we haven't had any official complaints about the decision CG - it was a horrific decision to make, you cannot predict what will happen. We were told with a lot of notice and schools have closed with less notice. We are parents who need to look after our own children. CH - we already had Primary 1 close earlier in the week and with the weather as well, it was likely to happen.

CH - (in reference to the Coffee, Crafts and Cake club on Friday) It has opened up conversations about different topics (sleep, etc).

AM showed Parent Council our Vision, Values and Aims poster that is available in the foyer area of the school – devised with pupils from Early, First and Second Level to see what each area looks like and sounds like.

There is no Highland Council policy that states (apart from ELC as it is required by a person over the age of 16) which children are able to walk home on their own - Aileen increasingly getting messages from parents with children in P2/3 allowing them to walk home themselves.

PC Members to have a think about trips for classes in and around the Inverness area

AM would like parents and local community/councillors involved to develop what the values look like in the community.

AM wants to be proactive in having a policy and a form to allow children to walk home from school/clubs themselves - RM, CM, ES agree to be part of working group.

Trial a Smithton Parent Charter we, as parents, are going to ensure that our children come with the right clothes, if there are any issues (i.e. with homework) they have communicated with parents. Would be included as part of enrolment pack. CH, HR & CM agree to be part of working group.
